



# Meeting California's Statewide Housing Needs

SB 35 Streamlining

Updated June 2023

**STATEWIDE: Jurisdictions subject to streamlined housing approval under SB 35 due to falling behind on addressing housing need**

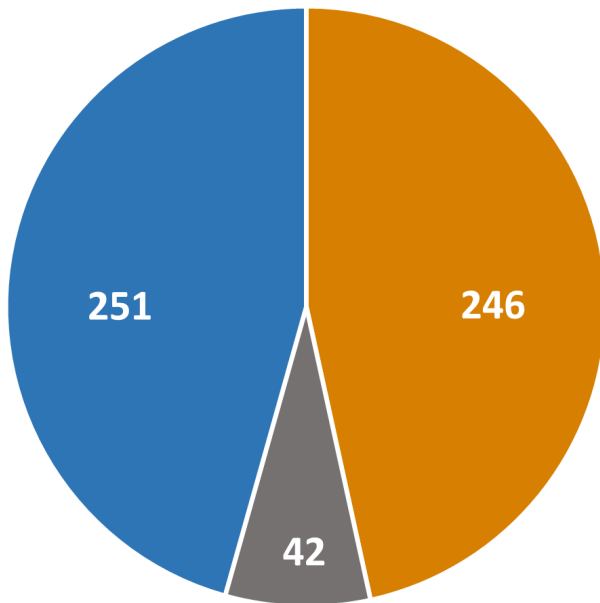
251 must offer streamlining for developments with ≥ 10% affordability

5.2% (28 jurisdictions) did not submit their 2022 Housing Element Annual Progress Report (APR)

41% (223 jurisdictions) have submitted their 2022 APR but are falling behind on addressing their above-moderate income housing need

246 must offer streamlining for developments with ≥ 50% affordability

46% (246 jurisdictions) are on track to meet their above-moderate income housing need and submitted their 2022 Housing Element APR, but are falling behind on addressing their lower-income housing need



- Jurisdictions subject to streamlining with ≥ 10% affordability
- Jurisdictions subject to streamlining with ≥ 50% affordability
- Jurisdictions not currently subject to SB 35, but are still encouraged to promote streamlining
