#### OOR Home Construction Continues

Four ReCoverCA homes have been completed in the past 30 days in communities throughout California. And construction is currently in progress on more than 20 additional homes that were damaged or destroyed in 2017 or 2018 disasters. In one case, a Butte County family's home was completed in just 66 days from groundbreaking to certificate of occupancy.

After a long wait for many homeowners, HCD is happy to report on progress. "HCD knows we can never truly replace all that was lost in these disasters," said Tim Tsai, Housing Recovery Program Manager for the California Department of Housing and Community Development. "But we hope that these high-quality, sustainable, and efficient homes will help survivors complete their road to recovery."

The ReCoverCA Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (OOR) is funding that helps complete rehab or reconstruction that remains after insurance, settlements, FEMA, and other programs have paid out. Stay tuned for more updates as additional homes are completed.

HCD hopes the extended timeline will allow more homeowners to get assistance rebuilding.

Eligible owners who have completed a ReCoverCA Housing Needs Assistance survey will be invited to complete the application through a case manager.
